Eklektika • Funkier Than Alice • Trio Zafiros

Eklektika is a 12-voice ensemble performing original works by musical director, Judith Stubbs, from a wide range of musical styles and cultures. Eklektika's outing as a finalist in MusicOz for classical composition, *Under One Sky*, was followed by a range of invited performances and commissioned works in 2005-06. *Under One Sky*, a commissioned mass that fuses Gregorian and ancient Sufi chant to create a vibrant, contemporary work, will be a feature of the concert. The bringing together of music from these spiritual traditions is a reminder of the debt western music pays to middle eastern influences, and the inter-relationships between these cultures, despite the current focus on difference.

Funkier Than Alice (Four Women and a Cello) take well known musical forms and turn them inside out to create fine a capella music, with a twist. Works performed will be featured in their forthcoming tour of India, at the invitation of the National Centre for Performing Arts, Mumbai.

Trio Zafiros Sarah Lambert, Heather Mitchell and Thomas Storer perform a selection of ethereal acapella songs from around the world, from classical to jazz to popular song.
